

CREATE A NEW BOOK JACKET

- ★ The front panel of your book jacket will be an illustration of a scene from the book. The cover must include the title of the book, the author's name, and a sentence describing the action of the scene.
- ★ The left inside cover will give a brief summary of the book including examples from the text.
- ★ The right inside cover will give a description of the main character of the book and the arc that he/she travels on.
- ★ The back cover of the book gives a review, using your analysis of the novel according to the 5 Facts of Fiction.
